We provide:

2 violins, 1 viola, 1 cello

4 x dpa „d:vote 4099“ microphones incl. holder

1 electric violin (Yamaha SV120) incl. effects (distortion, reverb)

2 percussion pads (Roland SPD::One Kick)

additional wind- and percussion instruments, such as recorder, harmonica, kazoo, glockenspiel, rain maker

We require on stage:

1 piano stool or chair without armrests for the cellist

4 uniform adjustable music stands

1 small table at the edge of the stage to deposit instruments

4 XLR inputs with 48V phantom power each (for our dpa instrument microphones)

3 DI boxes (jack) for electric violin and percussion pads

2 sockets on stage (for pedal board and percussion pads)

2 microphones (SM58 or similar) + adjustable stands + cables (or link) for moderation and vocals

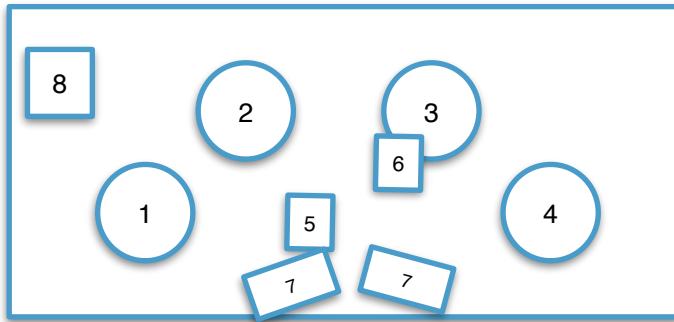
at least 4 XLR cables of sufficient lengths for our dpa instrument microphones

at least 4 jack cables of sufficient lengths for electric violin and percussion pads

2 independent monitors

8 AA batteries (for the case of emergency)

Our positions on stage:



- 1: violin 1 (standing)
- 2: violin 2, electric violin (standing)
- 3: cello, perc. pads, optionally kazoo/harmonice, vocals (sitting)
- 4: viola (standing)
- 5: microphone + stand for moderation
- 6: microphone + stand for moderation, vocals, and opt. kazoo/harmonica
- 7: monitors
- 8: small table

Lighting:

- background lighting in changing colours and combinations (blue, red, green, yellow, pink, ...)
- 4 white spots
- decent haze
- 4 moving heads

Recommended light settings:

- full black out (all lights off/dark)
- full black out + single spot light (on position 3)
- gradual brightening and dimming

At the day of the performance, a setlist with notes will be provided to all technicians and engineers. Lighting can be rehearsed during the soundcheck.
